

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF OTTAWA-CARLETON

BY-LAW NO. 54 OF 2000

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS: Being a by-law to confirm the proceedings and actions of the Council.

WHEREAS by Section 5 of the Regional Municipalities Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.R.8 (the "Act") the powers of The Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton (the "Regional Municipality") are to be exercised by its Council; and

WHEREAS pursuant to said Section 5 the powers of the Regional Council are to be exercised by by-law except where otherwise provided; and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and expedient that the proceedings of the Council as here in set forth be confirmed and adopted by by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Regional Municipality of Ottawa-Carleton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. ACTIONS CONFIRMED

The actions of the Council of the Regional Municipality at its meeting held on the 12th day of July 2000 in respect of each recommendation contained in the reports of the Standing Committees and Special Committees as adopted or amended and adopted and each motion and resolution passed and all other action taken by the said Council at this meeting is hereby adopted and confirmed as if all such proceedings were expressly embodied in this by-law.

2. FORMAL AUTHORIZATION

In the event that any act, motion, resolution or report is required to be authorized by by-law and no such by-law has been enacted, then this by-law shall be deemed for all purposes to be such authorization.

3. AUTHORIZATION OF OFFICERS

(a) The Chair and the proper officers of the Regional Municipality are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the actions of the said Council as authorized and confirmed hereby; and

(b) The Chair and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf and to affix thereto the seal of the Regional Corporation.


4. ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD APPROVAL

Section 1 does not apply to any action or matter to which Ontario Municipal Board approval is required until such approval is obtained but Section 3 applies for the purpose of obtaining such approval.


5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This by-law takes effect on the day of its final passing.
