4. MEASURING OF BASS FOR NOISE COMPLAINTS

That the Community and Protective Services Committee approve the addition of this item for consideration by the committee at today's meeting, pursuant to Section 84(3) of the Procedure By-law to ensure that operational staff has the approvals necessary to meet their project schedule .

CARRIED

Councillor Chernushenko began the discussion on this subject stating that bass noise has become a major irritant in all cities and all are grappling to get some control over it. He has a constituent who owns a pub as well as being an expert in scientific instrumentation. He uses his iPhone with an accelerometer app to measure deep bass so as to avoid complaints from neighbours.

Susan Jones, General Manager Emergency and Protective Services responded by saying that she had circulated a memorandum to all Council dated 25 August

2014 where she outlines that noise levels are covered under By-laws but that bass noise specifically has a different range and measured differently which is not measured by City By-law Officers.

More discussion ensued with Councillors Wilkinson and Clark joining the table to express their concerns. Susan Jones stated that the City would work with the NCC and the Special Events Advisory Team (SEAT) to better address the problems with bass noise at large events.
