### **REPORT RECOMMENDATIONS**

**That Transportation Committee recommend Council:**

- 1. Approve the Environmental Assessment Study's recommended plan for the multi-use (pedestrian and cycling) crossing of the OTrain corridor between Hickory Street and Adeline Street as described in this report; and**
- 2. Direct staff to finalize the Project File for the Multi-use Crossing of the O-Train Corridor near Hickory Street Environmental Assessment and post the Notice of Study Completion.**

Michael Powell, Dalhousie Community Association and Michelle Perry, Walk Ottawa were present in support of the staff recommendations.

The Committee received a letter dated 2 December from the Dalhousie Community Association, in support of the report recommendations. A copy is held on file with the City Clerk.

Robert Grimwood, Senior Project Manager, Sustainable Transportation responded to questions posed by Councillor Moffatt. Staff agreed to follow-up with regards to the funding of this project.

The report recommendation was then put to the Committee and CARRIED as presented, with Councillor S. Moffatt dissenting.
