REPORT RECOMMENDATION

That the Transportation Committee recommend that Council approve the installation of an all-way stop control at the intersection of Joshua Street and Saddleridge Drive.

Jeremy Wittet, Councillor's Assistant, Councillor Mitic's office, provided background related to the intersection and outlined concerns that area residents have raised regarding high levels of traffic in the area.

Krista Tanaka, Program Manager, Road Safety & Traffic Investments was present and responded to questions from members.

- to provide information on the process to give notice to switch a two way stop at an intersection from the major street to the minor street in terms of signage.
- to provide more information on the intersection of Joshua Street and Spring Valley Drive, which is located approximately 145 meters to the east of the proposed intersection (Joshua Street/Saddleridge Drive), where staff expect traffic volumes to remain higher as a result of future development plans for the area.
- to provide information on the process for removing the proposed All Way Stop Control (AWSC) at Joshua Street/Saddleridge Drive in the future and install the AWSC at Joshua Street/Spring Valley Drive to the east.
- to advise what possible better long term solutions would be for both
