

### Document 3: Gateway Speed Limit Signage By-law

BY-LAW No. 2018 – XXX

A by-law of the City of Ottawa to delegate the authority to the General Manager, Transportation Services Department to designate residential areas with gateway speed signage.

Whereas Subsections 128(2) and 128(2.1) of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.8., as amended, (*Highway Traffic Act*) authorize the Council of a municipality to designate by by-law a highway or part of a highway in its jurisdiction and prescribe a different rate of speed which is less than the 50 kilometres per hour prescribed under subsection 128(1)(a); and,

Whereas Ontario Regulation 301/18, came into force May 12, 2018, amending Signs Regulation 615, R.R.O. 1990 made under the *Highway Traffic Act* and prescribes certain signs which may be posted in designated residential areas as gateway speed limit signage with a reduced speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour,

Whereas Council desires to delegate the authority to the General Manager of Transportation Services Department to establish and designate those residential areas with a reduced speed limit and to post the associated gateway speed limit signage.

Now therefore the Council of the City of Ottawa enacts as follows:

1. That the General Manager, Transportation Services Department, be delegated the authority to establish and designate certain residential areas with a reduced speed limit of 40 kilometres per hour consistent with the Speed Zone Policy as determined by the General Manager of Transportation Services, and to post the associated gateway speed limit signage.
2. The exercise of delegated authority pursuant to subsection (1) shall be reported to the appropriate Standing Committee at least once in each calendar year.
