

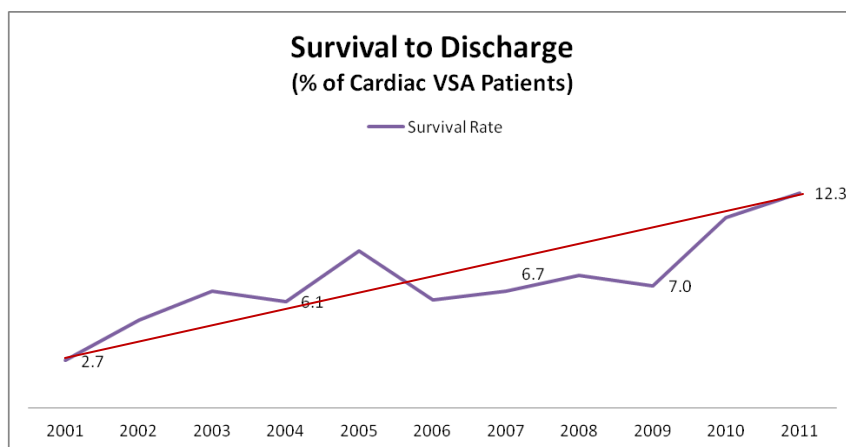

- 58 Return of Spontaneous Circulation (ROSC) following a sudden Cardiac Arrest since implementation of the PAD Program (2001);

- Bystander CPR rate: 17.7% ¹
