BACKGROUND

The Ontario Association of Police Services Boards' Fall Labour Seminar will be held in Mississauga, Ontario on October 10 – 11, 2019.

The program is not yet available however highlights of the seminar will include:

- Development of consensus-based common-front mandate for coordinated bargaining 2019-2022;
- Identification of lead agencies for the coordinated bargaining process for 2019-2022; and,
- Identification of member bargaining support needs, and exploration of options.

This information was previously circulated to Board members to determine their interest in attending. Chair Deans, Members Blaustein and Nirman, and Executive Director Ferraro have indicated they would attend on behalf of the Ottawa Police Services Board.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The total estimated cost of attending is \$1,600 per person. Funds were included in the 2019 Police Services Board budget for attendance at conferences and conventions in accordance with the Board's training policy. There are sufficient funds remaining in the Board's budget to meet this request.
