BACKGROUND

At its meeting of 12 September 2013, City Council approved a new structure for its Advisory Committee, which aligns these committees with the Term of Council Priorities. In order to determine the advisory committee's work plan, lead department staff provided information with respect to the applicable Term of Council Priorities and departmental work plan(s) and identified areas where the Advisory Committee could be of assistance in moving forward.

As such, the Arts, Culture, Heritage and Recreation Advisory Committee (ACHRAC) completed its work plan, which is attached to this report. At the end of the year, an annual report will be submitted to the standing committee to provide an update on the Advisory Committee's progress on each project.

DISCUSSION

The Arts, Culture, Heritage and Recreation Advisory Committee held its inaugural meeting on 23 April 2013, at which time it developed and approved its work plan, for submission to Standing Committee and Council.
