#### **REPORT RECOMMENDATION**

**That the Finance and Economic Development Committee recommend Council approve the appointments of Adam Wilson, Jessie Duffy and Vinayak Ethiraju to the Bank Street Business Improvement Area Board of Management for the 2018-2022 Term of Council or until a successor is appointed during the next term of Council.**

## **RECOMMANDATION DU RAPPORT**

**Que le Comité des finances et du développement économique recommande au Conseil municipal d'approuver les nominations de Adam Wilson, Jessie Duffy et Vinayak Ethiraju au conseil de gestion de la Zone d'amélioration commerciale de la rue Bank pour le mandat du Conseil 2018-2022 ou jusqu'à ce qu'un successeur soit nommé pendant le prochain mandat du Conseil.**

## **BACKGROUND**

Section 204 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 requires that the municipality appoint BIA Board members. At its 12 February 2019 meeting, City Council approved the appointments of members to the various Business Improvement Area (BIA) Management Boards in the City.

## **DISCUSSION**

In an e-mail dated October 1, 2020, the City Clerk's Office was notified of the appointments of Adam Wilson, Jessie Duffy and Vinayak Ethiraju to fill vacancies on its Board of Management and requested that Council approve the appointments of three (3) members.

Section 204 of the *Municipal Act* directs that Business Improvement Area Board member shall hold office until the expiration of the term of Council that appoints him/her. The new appointees will therefore serve until November 30, 2022.
